

Book Ordering Information for Schools, Libraries, Conferences and other Nonprofits Hosting Author IRENE LATHAM

Students and parents will often want books they can have autographed by the author, keep on their bookshelves, and read whenever they like.

If you are planning to have an author autographing, books can be ordered from a local bookstore or wholesaler, or books can be ordered direct from NewSouth Books (LEAVING GEE'S BEND), Macmillan (WILD PEACE, DON'T FEED THE BOY), Lerner (DICTIONARY FOR A BETTER WORLD, LOVE, AGNES; CAN I TOUCH YOUR HAIR?; DEAR WANDERING WILDEBEEST; WHEN THE SUN SHINES ON ANTARCTICA), and from Penguin Random House (D-39, MEET MISS FANCY, FRESH DELICIOUS, THE CAT MAN OF ALEPPO, NINE, THIS POEM IS A NEST).

All my publishers offer schools a discount. Also, unsold books are fully returnable. This provides schools with a no-risk way to help fund the author visit with Book Sales. 
Before photocopying, you will need to fill in:

You will receive a 40% discount off the cover price per book, with the option of returning unsold copies after the event. Payment by check only (no credit cards). Please place your order at least 3-4 weeks before the event. For more information and to place an order, contact:



When you order, you will need to provide the following information: author, date of appearance, quantities and title of book, billing and shipping addresses, and the name and telephone number of the contact person at our organization.

If you have not yet ordered through Macmillan, an account will be created for you. There is a 16 book minimum, and these titles are returnable. You are responsible for all shipping costs. Books are sent via UPS unless otherwise specified.

Contact Penguin Random House Customer Service at csorders@penginrandomhouse.com or call (800)733-3000. Be sure to tell customer service that you are ordering for an author visit. Let them know who you are hosting and the date that the visit takes place.

All author/illustrator visit orders receive a 40% discount and free outbound freight. (RHPS ships via ground transportation. Any rush order freight costs are the responsibility of the customer) All orders must be pre-paid. You must present appropriate tax exempt documentation to avoid paying tax. Unsold books are returnable (though you will be responsible for shipping cost).
